

FALL PROTECTION GENERAL REQUIREMENTS CHECKLIST

Places of employment, passageways, storerooms and service rooms must be kept clean, orderly and in a sanitary condition.

Comments:

Workroom floors must be kept clean and as dry as possible. If wet processes are used, drainage must be maintained and false floors, platforms, mats or other dry standing places provided "where practicable."

Comments:

Floors, working places and passageways must be kept free of protruding nails, splinters, holes or loose boards.

Comments:

Where mechanical handling equipment is used, there must be sufficient safe clearances for aisles, at loading docks, through doorways and wherever turns or passage must be made. Aisles and passageways must be kept clear and in good repair, with no obstruction across or in aisles that could create a hazard.

Permanent aisles and passageways must be appropriately marked.

Comments:

Covers and Guardrails must be provided to protect personnel from hazards of open pits, tanks, vats, ditches, etc.

Load capacities of floors used for industrial, storage and other purposes must be marked on plates of approved design and securely affixed in a conspicuous place and can't be removed or defaced. (**If they are, building owners must replace them.*)
